

AMENDMENT #3 INVITATION FOR BID MDM003103033496 Tibco Maintenance Renewal June 16, 2017

This Amendment is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named IFB. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this IFB. Specific parts of the IFB have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been underlined and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (ex. language deleted).

1. Amend IFB Section 3 – Bidder Minimum Qualifications as follows

The Bidder must be an authorized reseller of Tibco. As proof, the Bidder must submit with the bid a letter of authorization from the manufacturer or the manufacturer's distributor providing evidence of the Bidder's right to resell all products and services required by this IFB. The Bidder's right to resell all products and services required by this IFB is subject to confirmation with the manufacturer and or distributor by the Procurement Officer, which confirmation shall be undertaken at the sole option of the Procurement Officer. Further, by submitting a bid in response to this IFB, the individual signing the Bid on behalf of the Bidder attests that the Bidder is authorized to resell all products and services required by this IFB. A misrepresentation of a Bidder's authorization to resell all products and services required by this IFB may be considered a false statement under Md. Code Ann., State Finance and Procurement Article, § 11-205.1.

2. Add IFB Section 1.8 – False Statements

Offerors are advised that Md. Code Ann., State Finance and Procurement Article, § 11-205.1 provides as follows:

- 1.8.1 In connection with a procurement contract a person may not willfully: (a) Falsify, conceal, or suppress a material fact by any scheme or device; (b) Make a false or fraudulent statement or representation of a material fact; or (c) Use a false writing or document that contains a false or fraudulent statement or entry of a material fact.
- 1.8.2 A person may not aid or conspire with another person to commit an act under subsection (1) of this section.
- 1.8.3 A person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$20,000 or imprisonment not exceeding five years or both.
