


- Run by Area Health Education Center based in Cumberland
- Serves 3 western rural counties with 10 navigators
- Closely aligned with federally funded Rural Action & Enrollment Network (RAEN)
- Key partners include Mt. Laurel Medical Center, Tri-State Community Health Center, and The Beacon House
- New partnerships for FY2020 with Horizon Goodwill (16-24 year olds) and the Public Defender's Office



- Local non-profit serving the Baltimore metropolitan area – Baltimore city and Baltimore and Anne Arundel counties
- Key partners: Health Care for the Homeless, Chase Brexton Health Services, Bayview Medical Center, Total Health Care, The Recovery Network, St. Mary's Outreach Center (Baltimore), and Center of Help (Annapolis)
- 35 navigators; 9 Bi-lingual
- Two storefront locations, downtown Baltimore and Reisterstown

- HealthCare Access Maryland
- Howard, Carroll and Frederick counties
- Key partners: Chase Brexton, Frederick County Judy Center, Frederick County Community Action Agency, Access Carroll (health clinic), Seton Center, Centro Hispano, Asian American Center
- Program is closely associated with county health departments in Howard and Frederick counties
- 7 navigators located at agency and partner locations, including 2 bilingual navigators

Montgomery County Government

- Large County agency runs the program, co-located with Medicaid eligibility unit
- Diverse, metropolitan area borders Washington, D.C.
- Key partner: Mobile Medical Care, Inc., runs 9 clinics
- 14 navigators (17 during OE), all bi-lingual, located in 4 Montgomery County agency locations (Rockville, Germantown, Silver Spring)

MARYLAND HEALTH BENEFIT EXCHANGE



- Locally-based, state social services unit administers the program through sub-contracts with private, non-profits
- Large, densely-populated area borders Washington, D.C.
- Key partners: HealthCare Dynamics, Mary's Center, Institute for Public Health Innovation, Sowing Empowerment and Economic Development (SEED), Casa de Maryland
- 26 (15 bi-lingual) navigators located at storefronts and partner locations
- 2 walk-in sites located in retail centers

UPPER SHORE REGION

- Seedco is a non-profit focusing on health care and economic development
- Covers a large geographic area spanning Harford, Cecil, Queen Anne's, Kent, Caroline, Talbot and Dorchester counties
- Key partners: ESAHEC, Triangle Health Alliance, West Cecil Health Center, and Chesapeake Multicultural Resource Center
- 14 navigators (4 bi-lingual) staffed across regional locations, including 3 storefront locations in Elkton, Churchville and Cambridge


SOUTHERN REGION

- Seedco
- Charles, Calvert and St. Mary's counties, south of Washington, D.C., two of which are primarily rural
- 7 Navigators; 2 bi-lingual
- Key partners: Health Partners, MedStar, Chesapeake Project, Walden Behavior, Beacon of Hope, College of Southern MD, and Maryland Legal Aid
- Locations in DLLR, DHS, and LHD offices, and one store front in Waldorf (Charles County)

LOWER SHORE REGION

- Program based in local health department with community-member steering committee
- Very Rural 3-county region
- Key Partners: Chesapeake Health Care, Hudson Health Services, and Hope and Life Outreach Ministries
- 8 navigators, flexible staffing, often mobile during OE
- Navigator locations include LHDs, Job Centers, Peninsula Regional Medical Center, Ocean City Youth and Health Center, and local NAACP chapter
