COVID-19 Related System Changes

Background


MHBE will be reverting several COVID-19 related emergency system changes in the coming months to align with Federal and State Medicaid and QHP policies post COVID-19 emergency. MHBE filed an emergency APD (Advanced Planning Document) with the CMS on 05/08/2020 seeking additional funding of \$521,500 at the rate of 90/10 Federal/State participation. CMS Approved the request on 05/21/2020.


Anticipated System Changes

- Reverting COVID-19 Special Enrollment Period (SEP).
- Changes to IRS tax filing/reconciliation for eligibility for Advanced Premium Tax Credits (APTC).
- Messaging changes throughout the system and the Chatbot.
- System changes to revert Medicaid and QHP batches related to 90-Day Disenrollment, Termination, Age-Out, Postpartum, Periodic Data Matching (PDM), and extending Medicaid enrollments in line with post-COVID-19 federal regulations.
- System Changes and data reconciliation between the Maryland Department of Health's Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) and HBX.
- Reporting requirements for CMS, Medicaid and other agencies.

Background

MHBE uses Corticon Business Rules Engine software for the end-to-end automation and management of Eligibility & Enrollment decision making functions of the Health Benefit Exchange (HBX) System.

Procurement Summary
