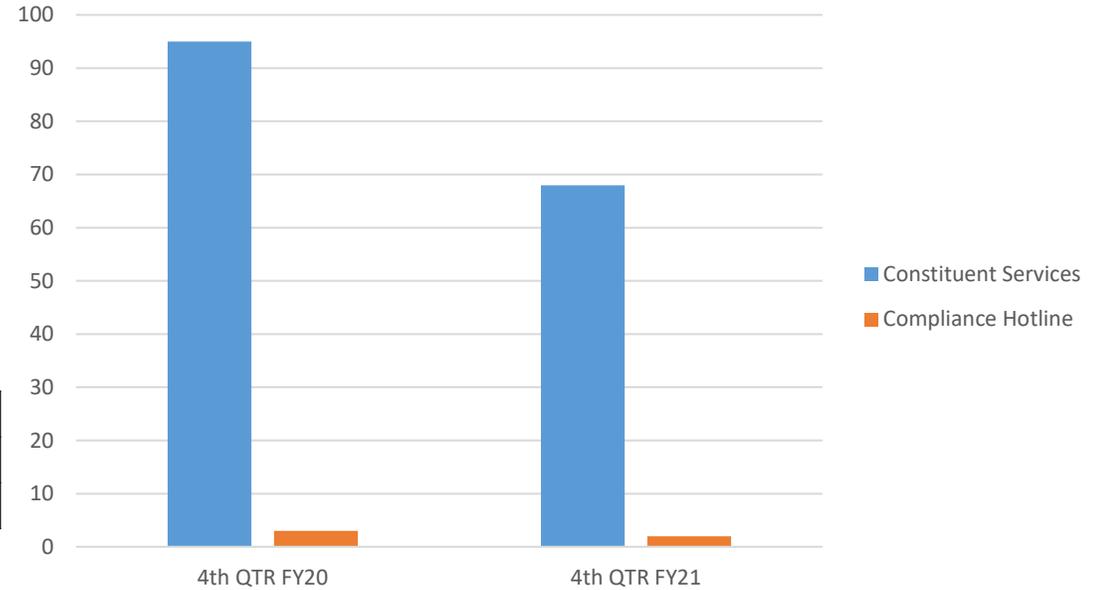

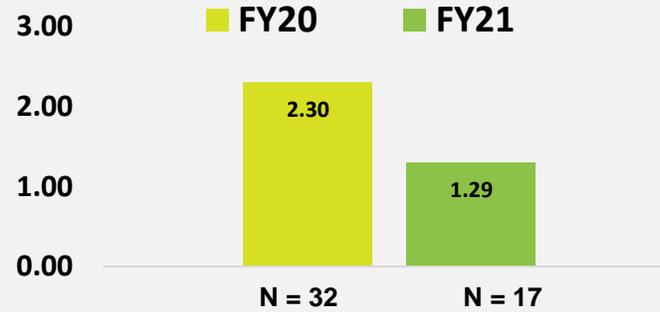

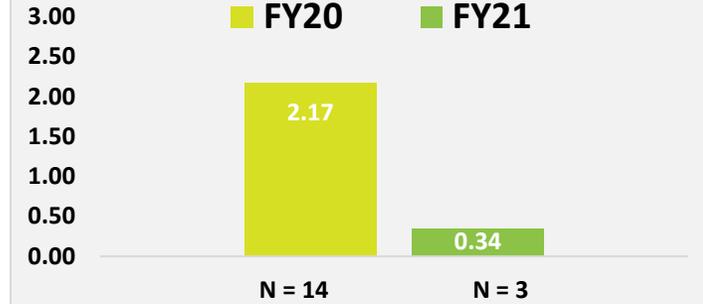
Rate of Non-Producer Incidents Per 10,000 Enrollments



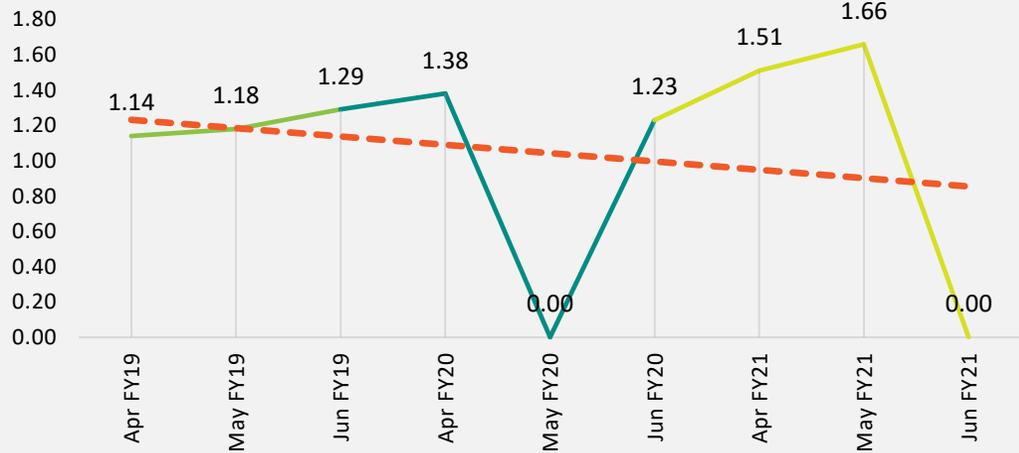
44% Decrease in Rate of Misloads Per 10,000 VCL Uploads



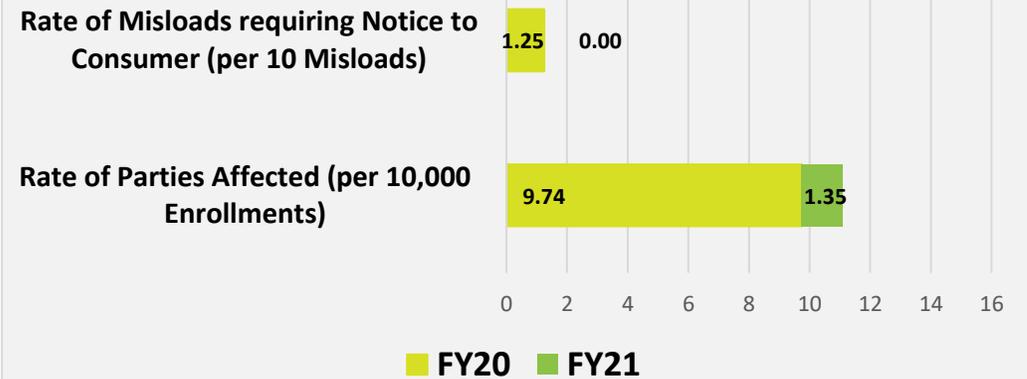
84% Decrease in Producer Rate Per 1,000 Producer Enrollments

OLA Triennial Findings – Status Update

Finding 1 – Use other income and electronic data sources to verify income

- ❖ MDH internal assessment to obtain income at point of application. Projected: June 2022
- ❖ Receive BEACON Unemployment Compensation data. Projected: ~September 2021

Finding 2 – Independently review eligibility overrides

- ❖ Supervisory review and revision of override applications and communication back to staff implemented: July 2021
- ❖ Override Review Policy. Delayed: August 2021

Finding 3 – Use Multifactor Authentication and filter traffic for certain remote third parties. Completed.

Other Findings Requiring Agency Action

- ❖ Enhance bid security. Testing Implemented: June 2021
- ❖ Perform impact analysis of data loss prevention application at the column or database level.
Projected: August 31, 2021
If indicated, Implement: June 30, 2022
