




July 31, 2024

- July 2024 ended with 216,116 enrollments in private plans on Maryland Health Connection. That is slightly down from the 216,706 enrolled at the end of June 2024. But it's still the highest July enrollment in the 11-year history of the state health exchange and a 16% increase from July 2023.
- Income-based Medicaid enrollments totaled 1,221,412 at the end of July. That is lower than at any
 point in 2023 or 2022. It's about 2 percent higher than in July 2021 (1,202,542).
- New enrollments keep commanding a higher proportion of total enrollments, up to 34%. That breaks last month's all-time record for new enrollments of 32% of all private plans.
- 7,642 people enrolled through a special enrollment for people who had lost coverage anytime
 during the prior or coming 60 days. That was the highest month since September 2023, perhaps a
 reflection of the end of a year-long "Medicaid Unwinding" when eligibility requirements that had
 been suspended in response to the Covid-19 public health emergency were reinstated.
- New enrollments for July 2024 alone (9,207) were down 68% compared to new enrollments during July 2023 (15,455). That followed a 48%-drop in new enrollments the prior month, in June. That is also a reflection of the renewed eligibility rules for Medicaid compared to last summer.
- July marked the highest enrollment in six months in the "Easy Enrollment" program coordinated through the Maryland Department of Labor for people who filed for unemployment compensation. In July, a total of 7,867 filers checked a box on their unemployment applications to enroll in Medicaid and private plans through Maryland Health Connection, the most since January.









Income Based Medicaid Summary




Enrollments 2023 vs 2024





Enrollees by Age Group
















PRIVATE PLANS - CHANGE IN ENROLLMENTS BY RACE / ETHNICITY BY COUNTY (Compared to one year earlier)










YOUNG ADULT SUBSIDY







Dental Enrollments '23 vs. '24










MEDICAID (MAGI/Income-based) BY COUNTY
