


DATA REPORT

January 31, 2025

- January 2025 ended with 249,603 enrolled in Maryland Health Connection. That was up 16% from 214,892 the prior January.
- Income-based Medicaid enrollment ended January 2025 at 1,161,480. That was down 7% from 1,246,240 the prior January.
- The split between renewals and new enrollees in private health insurance plans through Maryland Health Connection was 77% renewals / 23% new in January. That was a slight change from one year ago: 76% renewals / 24% new enrollees.
- New enrollees at the end of January totaled 36,131. That was up 7% from 33,677 one year earlier. But renewals of existing enrollees were up by even more 17% to 191,108 from 162,666 a year earlier.
- Enrollments by Hispanic residents were up 25% year over year, with greater-than-50% gains in Caroline and Somerset counties. Enrollment by Black residents were 23% year over year with the largest gain of 48% in Wicomico County.
- Net premiums that is, the monthly premium for health insurance minus federal tax credits for those eligible were slightly lower in January 2025 than in January 2024 for all incomes below 300% of the federal poverty line. (The FPL for 2025 is an annual household income of \$15,650 for an individual and \$32,150 for a family of four.)
- Enrollments by young adults (ages 18-37) were 90,875. That is up 45% from 62,599 one year earlier. Of that total, 68,509 qualified from the state's Young Adult Subsidy, up 48% from 46,147 one year earlier.
- Enrollments in dental insurance through Maryland Health Connection totaled 94,411 at the end of January, up 26% from 75,154 the prior January.











# PRIVATE PLANS BY TOP 6 JURISDICTIONS




#### PRIVATE PLAN SELECTIONS-Top 15 Plans






Dental Enrollments '24 vs. '25




#### SMALL BUSINESS HEALTH OPTIONS PROGRAM (SHOP) ENROLLMENT








# MEDICAID (MAGI/Income-based) BY COUNTY




