


DATA REPORT

February 28, 2025

- February 2025 ended with 243,595 enrolled, down 2% from January. But churn has been common in February, the first month following the open enrollment period in recent years. By comparison, February 2024 declined 1% from the prior month. February 2023 declined 3% from the prior month.
- Coverage for more than 11,000 individuals was cancelled in February, the most in the two years we have tracked that by month, but it was against a much larger base.
- February's total was 15% higher than the 212,576 total in February 2024.
- The percentage split between renewal and new enrollments 75 / 25 was the exact same as a year earlier. Just as the split between enrollees with and without tax credits 78 / 22 was the same a year earlier.
- "Easy Enrollment" for state unemployment filers topped 3,000 Medicaid enrollments for the fifth consecutive month. Conversely, private-plan enrollments through the program dipped below 1,000 for the first time in five months. The program is a cooperation between the Comptroller of Maryland and MHBE to help people who have lost jobs and income retain health coverage.
- The special enrollment for households below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level in February topped 1,500 for only the second time in two years and hundreds higher than the last two Februaries.
- Young adult enrollment (18-37) of 89,059 was 21% higher than one year earlier. Most of the increase was due to enrollees who qualified for the state's young adult subsidy. The total of 18-37 year-olds enrolled was down 2% from January, in line with the monthly decline overall for private plans through Maryland Health Connection.
- About 74% of the young adults enrolled qualified for the state's subsidy to lower their monthly cost by an average of \$38. That was a higher share than a year ago when about 62% of all young adults enrolled qualified for the subsidy, which averaged \$44 then.
- Dental enrollments were up 30% to 87,548 year over year. The total was 6% less than January.
- Income-based Medicaid enrollments totaled 1,154,342 at the end of February. That was down 8% from one year earlier and down less than 1% from January 2025.











# PRIVATE PLANS BY TOP 6 JURISDICTIONS




#### PRIVATE PLAN SELECTIONS-Top 15 Plans



## PRIVATE PLANS - CHANGE IN ENROLLMENTS BY RACE / ETHNICITY BY COUNTY (Compared to one year earlier)








Dental Enrollments '24 vs. '25




#### SMALL BUSINESS HEALTH OPTIONS PROGRAM (SHOP) ENROLLMENT






# MEDICAID (MAGI/Income-based) BY COUNTY




